Responsibilities: The University of Central Florida (UCF) Libraries is accepting applications for two full-time librarians to serve in joint-use libraries at the Seminole State College Sanford/Lake Mary Campus or at Daytona State College. Regional Campus librarians participate in service delivery with college librarians in a shared facility and report to the UCF Head of Regional Campus Libraries. Primary responsibilities include participation in all modes of reference, library instruction, outreach and collection development duties in a partnership environment. Regional campus librarians maintain current knowledge of numerous print and electronic resources, as well as procedures related to document delivery, interlibrary loan, and other library services. They participate in regular electronic meetings and attend meetings on the UCF Orlando campus. Evening and weekend hours are required.

Qualifications:

Required:

- Master's degree from an American Library Association accredited institution.

Preferred:

- Experience with academic, regional campus, joint-use or distance learning librarianship
- Demonstrated facility with virtual reference and Web technologies
- Evidence of active participation in information literacy and instruction programs with experience in preparation of instruction materials or tutorials
- Commitment to public service for a variety of constituents
- Flexibility, initiative and ability to work both independently and collaboratively
- Involvement in professional activities.

Environment: The University of Central Florida is the nation's 2nd largest public university, enrolling over 59,000 students and offering 91 bachelor's, 92 master's, and 29 doctoral programs. The main UCF library and branches have a collection of 2.1 million volumes, subscription base of 29,000 serials, and serve as a partial depository for government documents and patents.
