- ✘ Purpose was “to recognize the good work being accomplished in the collaboration between UCF and Brevard Community College.”

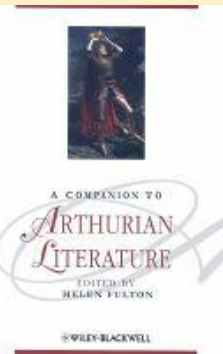
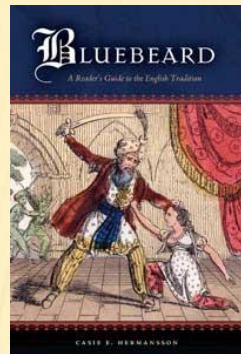
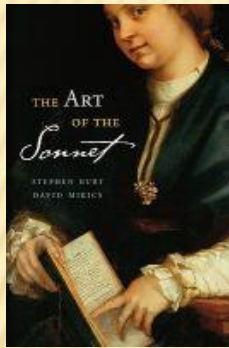


# PROGRESS

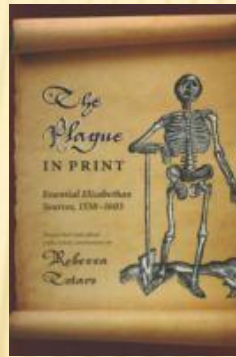
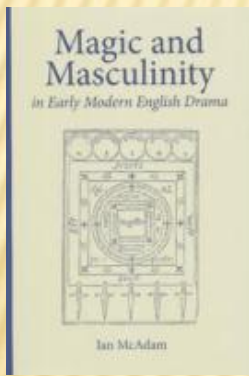

- ✘ To date, over 175 titles related to the humanities and Shakespearian studies have been added to the Carpenter Collection in Cocoa.
- ✘ The Oxford English Dictionary (OED) online database subscription for the UCF Libraries has been graciously funded by the John Archer Carpenter Library Enhancement Fund since 2007. This OED is considered the largest dictionary of word descriptions and history of usage and continues to be a valued database for UCF students.

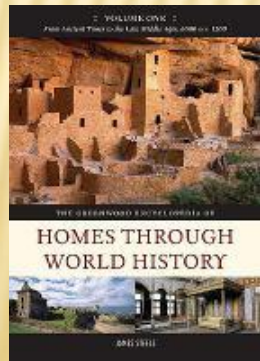
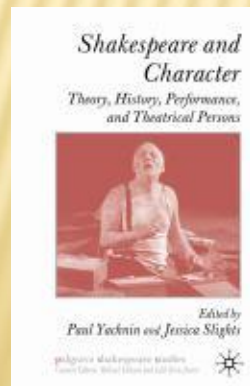
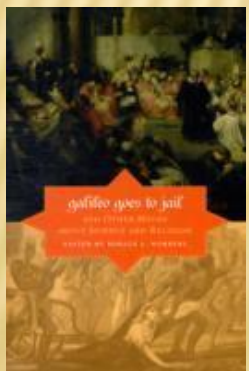
