UCF Course Reserves gives students access to materials professors have selected for their courses. Reserves may include physical items held at the library (such as books or videos) or electronic documents accessible from a computer.

### Finding Your Instructor's Course Reserves

- Go to the library homepage: <http://library.ucf.edu/rosen>
- Click on the **Reserves** tab
- Type in your instructor's last name and click "Search." Note: you may also search by course, course number, or department by clicking the drop-down arrow.



- A list of instructors will appear. Click on your instructor's last name to view a list of course reserve titles. Each title's author, location or link for accessing the material, and course number is given. If you need to access a reserve item held physically at the library (such as a book or video), simply ask for the item at the front desk.

### Viewing Electronic Course Reserves

- If you need to access an electronic reserve item, simply click the link provided.



- A new window will open with copyright information. Read the information and then click the icon at the bottom of the window to view the course reading.
